Human Rights Policy

BenQ supports and follows internationally recognized human rights norms and principles, including the "United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights", "United Nations Global Covenant", "United Nations Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights " And the Declaration of Fundamental Principles and Rights of Work issued by the International Labor Organization. Human rights policies are formulated in accordance with the local laws and regulations of the company, and human rights protection is implemented through human rights principles "safeguard, respect, and remedy".

Scope

BenQ's human rights policy applies to our own operation and its investment companies, including employees, customers, suppliers, and partners. We also require our suppliers and partners to uphold human rights to the same standards as this policy.

Implementation

Regarding the major human rights issues of BenQ Technology, the following policies have been formulated:

- Provide a safe and healthy working environment
- Ensure equal job opportunities
- Prohibit any form of discrimination and harassment
- Provide fair and reasonable wages and working conditions
- Respect employees' freedom of assembly and association
- Prohibition of child labor and forced labor
- Pay a fair and full living wage on time
- Adhering to the values of integrity, anti-corruption, prohibition of accepting or offering bribes
- Provide communication channels for stakeholders
- Assess potential human rights issues and implement appropriate mitigation actions
